March Class Descriptions

1 Book, 2 Book, Red Book , Blue Book- Reading books aloud and playing with language help create strong literacy skills. Dr. Seuss books are great for reading aloud. Hear the playful language and rhymes of his books and play games in honor of Dr. Seuss's birthday.

Ask a Pediatrician from UNLV School of Medicine - A Children's Health topic will be presented from a Pediatric Resident Physician from the University of Nevada Las Vegas-School of Medicine. Topics change each week and covers a range of issues including Child Car Seats, Nutrition, Obesity, Vaccines, Breastfeeding, Smoking Dangers, and much more. The presentation will be followed by a brief Q&A session where you can ask the Pediatrician any questions about their presentation or anything else about your child's health.

Amazing Mazes- Don't get lost in the maze! Join F2F staff find their way out of the maze while implementing math, science, literacy, and art.

Backwards Day- Forget everything you know and join us for a silly day of backwards activities! We will have movement, crafts, and lots of backward learning fun. And don't forget to dress the part- wear your clothes backwards for a special prize!

Cooking Live with Chef JI- Chef Jose delights F2F with his culinary skills, while teaching parents and children fun, simple, and delicious recipes.

Developmental Activities- The early years are the time to build a strong foundation in all developmental areas. Join us as we engage in fun activities that touch on all five developmental domains: cognitive, physical, social/emotional, language, and self-help/adaptive development. Meeting specific milestones in all five domains of development and learning helps preschoolers establish behaviors and skills that will make them successful. Taught by F2F Staff.

Imagination Nature Trail- Let's take a "walk" thorough nature and discover animals, trees, and flowers along the way.

Jump, Jump, Jump - This class is designed for toddlers who are already walking. The purpose of the class is to provide opportunity for physical activity and fun which promotes large muscle development and exercises coordination and balance. **PARENT PARTICIPATION AND CLOSE SUPERVISION IS MANDATORY FOR THIS CLASS!!!**

Let's Explore Ladybugs – Ladybugs are the cutest and friendliest of insects. They're also a big help to gardeners. Join F2F staff in the exploration of these friendly helpers.

Life Skills w/ Miss Dianne- Dianne Farkas, the executive director of Family to Family Connection is very passionate about the future of a child's life. Monthly, Miss Dianne will be encouraging and teaching parents on how to prepare their children with skills they will need to further succeed in the world around them.

Library Day- Library Day is a great day for children and parents to explore and utilize their local library.

March is Women's History Month- Celebrate Women's history month learning about the pioneering spirit of Amelia Earhart, the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.

Months of the Year- The children will learn the months of the year as well as the days of the week with F2F Staff.

Nursery Rhyme – Nursery Rhyme time for the children and parents. Come and enjoy a sing-a-long, crafts and socializing with friends. Lead by F2F staff.

Place Based Learning Outing- Place Based Learning is experiential education that is in the student's own community: art, literature, culture, and environment.

Snack Time- We will provide a snack for your child to enjoy while they visit with the friends. Donations welcome.
